



**1) GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS of HARDWARE SALE (All Products)**

- 1.1) Delivery : Ex Works Middlesbrough UK (EXW Incoterms 2020).
- 1.2) Documentation : This quotation includes Certificate of Conformity to BS EN 10204-2.1 and Installation Instructions (if applicable). We will be happy to quote for additional documentation should your requirements be more extensive.
- 1.3) Currency : GBP (£).
- Value Added Tax : The quotation does not include for VAT; which will be charged extra at the current rate (if applicable).
- 1.4) Validity : The quotation is valid for 30 days from the date of quotation, based on prevailing exchange rate, after which time it should be reconfirmed. We reserve the right to adjust the pricing within the validity period if the exchange rates vary +/- 5%.
- 1.5) Payment Terms : Net cash 30 days from the date of our invoice (subject to appropriate export credit guarantee cover from our insurers relevant to all export orders / invoices. Should credit cover be refused for whatever reason, alternative terms of payment must be agreed). Non Account holders will be on a pro-forma invoice terms.
- 1.6) Retention : This quotation is issued on the understanding that any subsequent order would be free of any retention.
- 1.7) Terms & Conditions : This quotation and any subsequent order are subject to our standard conditions of sale, a copy of which is available upon request.
- 1.8) Specifications : ENEX Group Ltd will evaluate and action the specifications relevant to the supply of the hardware, all documents not applicable will be discarded.

**2) PRODUCT SPECIFIC TERMS & CONDITIONS (ENEX i-LOCK)**

- 2.1) Despatch : In working weeks &/or days from receipt of your purchase order with confirmed host equipment and system engineering details to allow design & manufacturing to proceed, (please see points 2.2 to 2.2.5 below).
- 2.2) Engineering Details : Should you wish to place an order it would expedite the supply of the material to you if the following information could be supplied or confirmed in your purchase order.
  - 2.2.1) Engineering Data : Full host equipment engineering dimensional details on which the ENEX i-LOCK are to be installed upon or details of the host equipment supplier (order number, product type, size, class, operator etc.) in order that we can obtain the necessary details on your behalf. Alternatively, we can quote to carry out a detailed engineering survey of the host equipment at site or free issue host equipment can be surveyed at ENEX Group HQ manufacturing facility.
  - 2.2.2) Logic Sequence : Full Mechanical Trapped Key Interlock operating logic sequence.
  - 2.2.3) Interlock Tagging : Full tagging details that you or your client, require attaching to the ENEX i-LOCK, for example Tag No SP1234 – PSV567-V1
  - 2.2.4) Key Tagging : Full Key Tag colour and details that you or your client require, for example SP1234 – KEY A in black text on yellow background.
  - 2.2.5) End Site / Platform : Complete Identification of the final site / platform where the ENEX i-LOCK will be installed to enable and allow the appropriate lock and key codes to be allocated.
